We have been working hard to learn our tables and are making great progress. Next week we will be re starting our weekly times tables sessions in class. Please assist your children in becoming confident with the tables set out below. This could include counting in the given number, reciting the table, asking questions from within the table and discussing real life problems (i.e. 4 children each want 2 fish fingers, how many do I need ?) Alongside learning the multiplication facts, we would like the children to know the associated division facts (i.e. 2x 4=8 so 8 divided by 2 = 4, or I have 8 fish fingers to share equally between 4 children, how many can they each have?)
